



Competition for a scholarship to present at a scientific conference 2021-22:

This competition is open to all MSc, PhD and postdoc students of a regular Network member. The deadline for student applications this year is **Friday May 28, 2021 at 11:59 pm**. Ten (10) scholarships of up to \$1,000 will be offered to support students' active participation (poster or oral presentation) at a national or international conference. **Exceptionally, due to the pandemic, the scholarships can also be used for the registration to a virtual conference in 2021.** The conference must be held in the year the grant is awarded. **Only one student per regular member of the QRHN will be eligible for this grant.**

2- A document in **PDF format** including all the following sections:

- a-Explanatory letter, with the student's signature, to justify the application.
- b-Common Canadian CV of the student.
- c-Letter signed by the supervisor highlighting his/her participation and involvement in the SERP.
- d-Confirmation of conference registration (may be provided later if not available at time of application).
- e-Confirmation of the presentation at the conference (oral presentation / poster) (can be provided later if not available at the time of application).
- f-Title and text of the submitted abstract.
- g-Estimated costs in \$ CDN (financial package).

Applications will be evaluated on 2 criteria:

-The contribution of the student's director to the development of the Network: 5 points

-The student's CV and the scientific quality of the abstract submitted: 5 points

Applications may be made for a conference that will take place later in the year. Please indicate this in the "Note" section of the electronic form. Missing documents can be sent by email to Dr André Dagenais (Confirmation of registration, Confirmation of presentation, etc...) when they are available (see contact information below).

Eligible expenses are as follows:

1.registration fee

2.transportation costs

3.accommodation costs

4.meals not covered by the conference registration fee (excluding alcohol).

Original invoices and boarding passes for air travel are required for reimbursement.
