



Quebec Respiratory Health research Network Scholarship Supplement Program

The Quebec Respiratory Health research Network (QRHN) offers a **scholarship supplement program** for student members of the Network. The program aims to foster networking and collaborations (collaborative research, exchange between laboratories) between regular members of QRHN. According to FRQ-S regulations, the scholarship supplement is \$ 5,000 for a master's student and \$ 10,000 for a doctoral student or postdoctoral fellow.

Are eligible, all **M.Sc. and Ph.D. students** as well as **postdoctoral fellows** who do not already hold a scholarship from a granting agency. Students with a scholarship are not eligible.

The deadline to submit application is **June 9, 2022 at 11:59 pm.**

The scholarships will be effective from **July 1st 2022** to **June 30 2023**. Applicants who will start in September in their host laboratory are also eligible.

The scholarship supplement has 2 main objectives:

1-Promote collaboration and networking within QRHN.

2-Help students to obtain a scholarship from public granting agencies or the industry (FRQ-S, CIHR ...).

To submit an application:

1-Complete the form on the website at the following address:

2- A PDF document including all of the following sections must be linked to the application:

a-Title and summary of the research project (one page)

b-Letter co-signed by the student's director and the collaborating researcher justifying the collaborative aspect of the student's project and mentioning their involvement in the activities of the Network.

c-Canadian Common CV (CIHR format) of the student.

Financial arrangement

The director agrees to offer a minimum total amount/ year (including the supplement from QRHN) of \$ 12,000 for a M.Sc. student, \$ 18,000 for a Ph.D. and \$ 20,000 for postdoctoral fellows. The amounts supplementing QRHN scholarship may come from a variety of sources including industry, research director's research funds, institutional scholarships, or any other award. Students who have already accumulated **\$10,000** from institutional, granting agency or foundation scholarships are not eligible for the QRHN scholarship supplement.

General conditions of the award

- Application are evaluated by referees.
- The candidates must limit themselves to the prescribed number of pages and format and provide the required documents. Non-compliant requests will be rejected.
- The awardees agree to declare any other source of income (new scholarship) during the year of the scholarship.

- The scholarship is awarded to one candidate per regular member.
